

Pattern and sewing Military cap

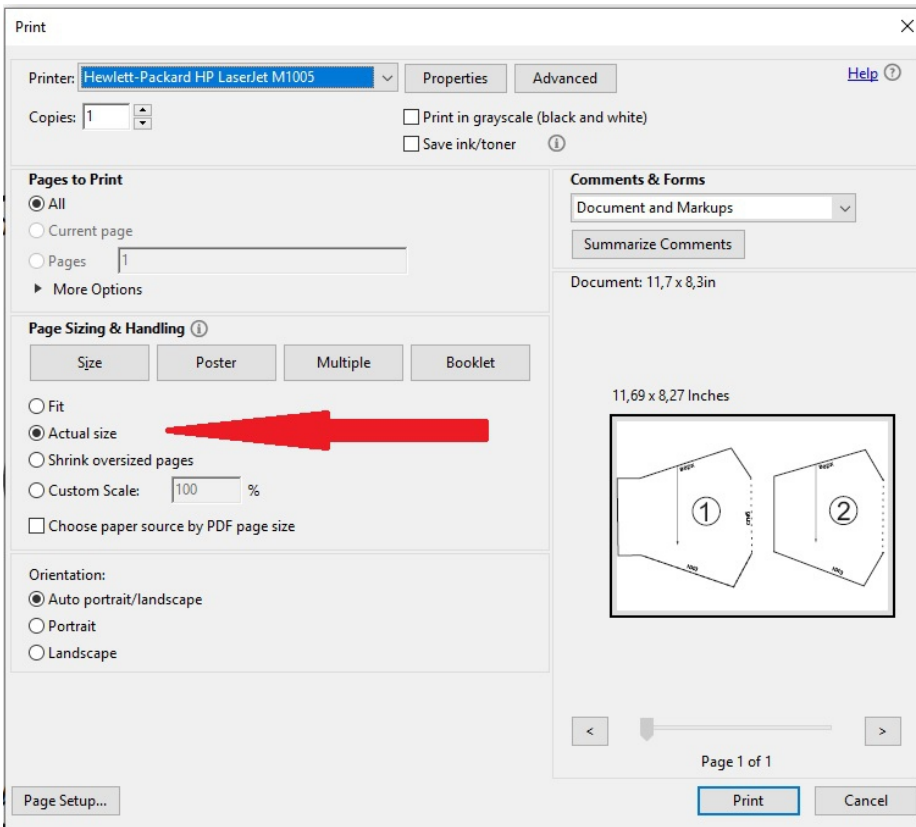


Recommended materials:

1 piece of fabric 1yd x 0.5yd (90 x 45cm)

Scissors, Pencil, Pins, Threads, Pattern
Measuring tape

Light weight interfacing for the visor: 12 x 8"(30x20cm)



Prepare pattern pieces

Printing the pattern

You will need:

PDF Reader

Printer

3 sheets of paper (A4 or Letter)

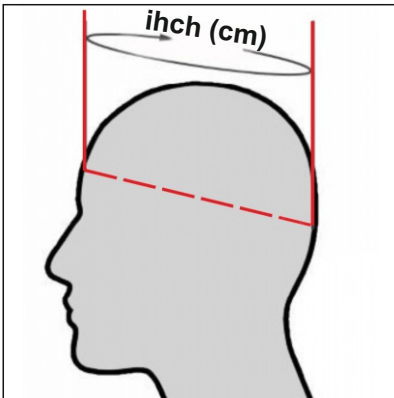
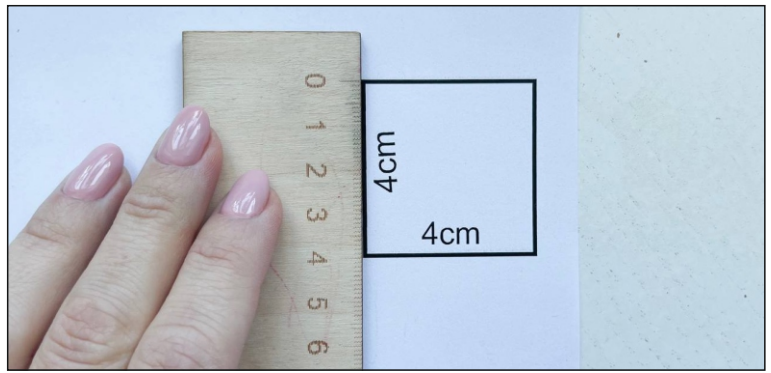
Scissors

Ruler

Sealing tape

Open file in PDF Reader (for example Adobe Acrobat Reader), click "Print". Make sure that you print in "Actual size", as shown on the screenshot

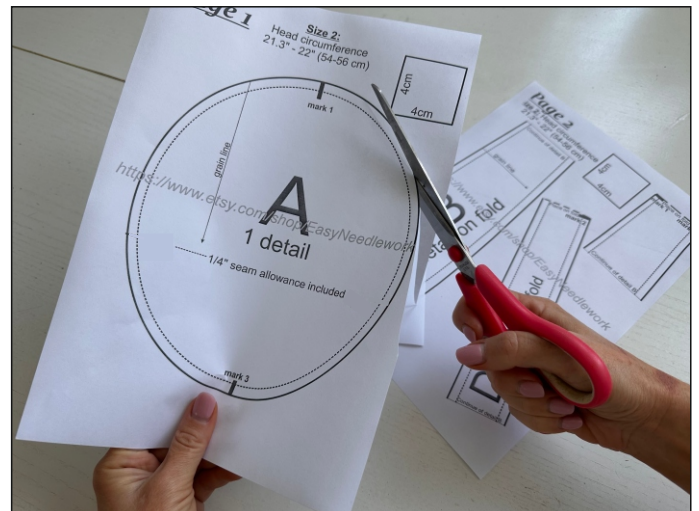
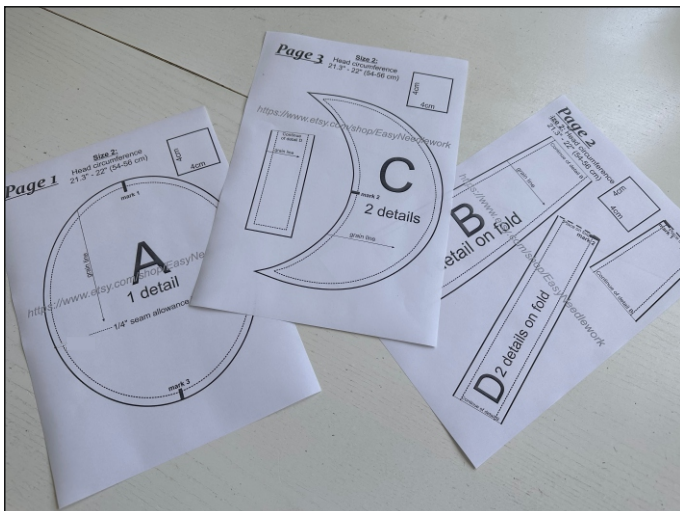
Important!
Check either side of the test square, it should be 4 cm.
(1,57")



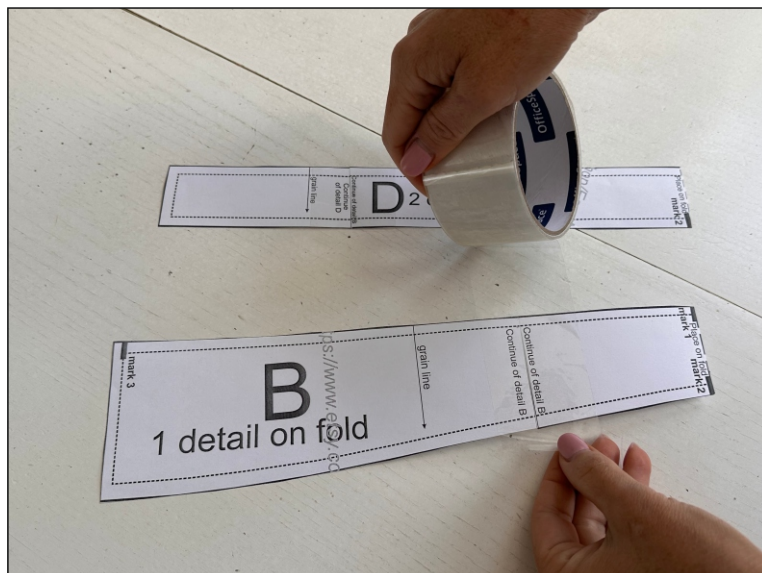
Measure the circumference of your head and choose the right size for your pattern

Size	Head circumference (inch)	Head circumference (cm)
Size 1	20"- 20,9"	51-53 cm
Size 2	21.3"-22"	54-56 cm
Size 3	22.4"-23.2"	57-59 cm
Size 4	23.6"-24.4"	60-62 cm

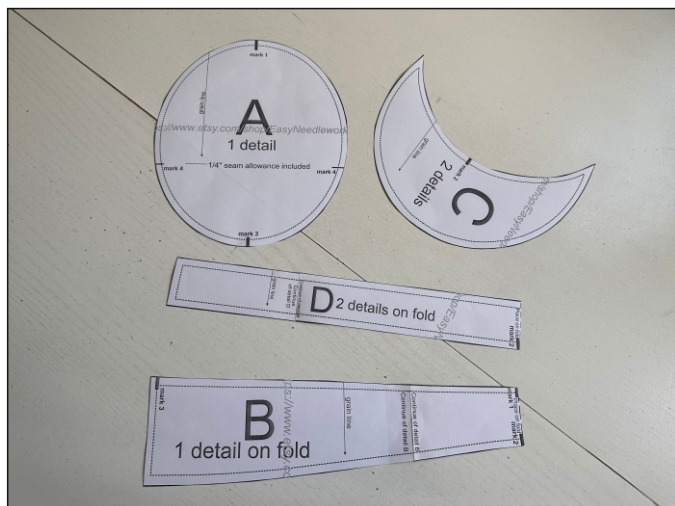
Pattern on 3 sheets of paper. Cut the patterns along the contour.



Connect the two parts of patterns B and D as shown in the photo and glue them together with sealing tape. Pattern is ready!
